If 7-8 with limited cricketing experience  <b>Best:</b> Master Blaster (girls only)	<b>When:</b> Saturday morning 10.30- 12.45 27 October to 16 March <b>Where:</b> Girls Hub. David Thomas oval, Manly Vale <b>Type:</b> Games with soft ball and plastic bat
If under 11 with limited cricketing experience  <b>Best:</b> MWJCA Sixers Girls League Under 11 (girls only)	<b>When:</b> Saturday morning 10.30-12.45 20 October to 16 March <b>Where:</b> Girls Hub. David Thomas Oval, Manly Vale. <b>Type:</b> Semi-hard ball, protective equipment, 7 a-side, face 17 deliveries
If some cricket experience and happy to face hard ball:  <b>Best:</b> MWJCA Sixers Girls League Under 13 and under 15 age groups (with dispensation considered for those older)	<b>When:</b> Saturday afternoon 1.00 - 3.30pm 20 October to 16 March <b>Where:</b> Girls Hub. David Thomas/Millers Oval, Manly Vale <b>Type:</b> Hard ball, protective equipment, 9 a-side, T20 format with some longer formats for u/15
Option to join a predominantly boys Saturday morning mixed team.  Girls can play up to 1 year below their age group.	<b>When:</b> Saturday morning 8 September to 16 March <b>Where:</b> Northern Beaches <b>Type:</b> Dependent upon age group
